Installation:

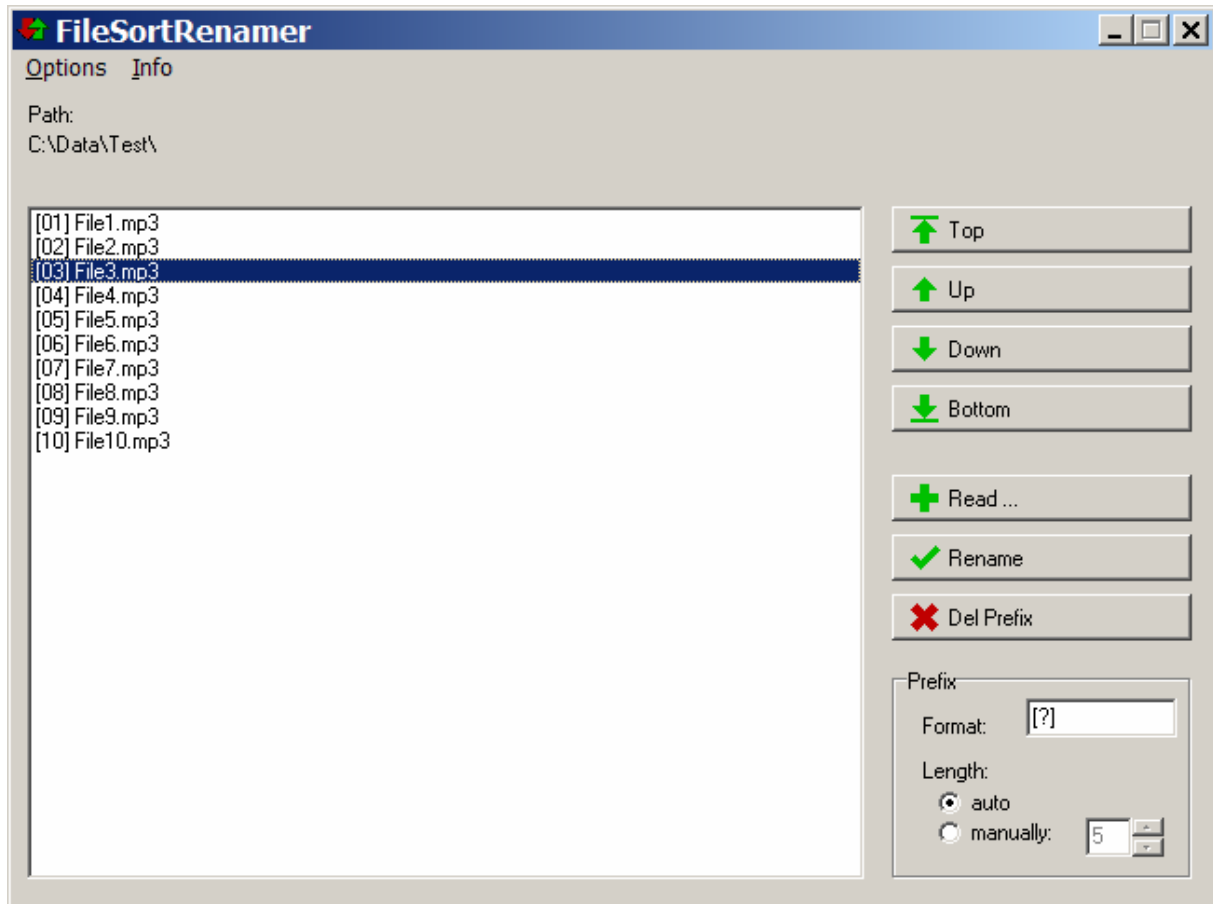
FileSortRenamer runs from Windows 95.

Simply copy the files into any directory (e.g.: *C:\Program Files\FileSortRenamer*).



Operation:

The program starts by choosing *FileSortRenamer.exe*.



Read: Opens a file dialog where the desired files can be chosen. Many files can be chosen by holding down the shift or ctrl key. A possibly present list would be deleted. It's always only possible to choose files in one directory.

Rename: The displayed files, as seen in the list, will be renamed. After that the list will be deleted.

Del Prefix: At the displayed files a possibly present prefix will be deleted. The prefix will be chosen by the actually set prefix format (space signs at the end will be ignored). That means that all signs to the last sign of the prefix format will be deleted. After that possibly leading space signs will be also deleted.

e.g.:

Prefix format: [?]

[00001] File1.mp3	→	File1.mp3
File2.mp3	→	File2.mp3
File[]3.mp3	→	3.mp3

After that the list will be deleted.

**Prefix:**

Format: Specifies the string that will be put before the file names. A question mark stands for a sequential number.

Length: Specifies the length of the sequential number. At *manually* the length can be chosen from 1 to 10. At *auto* the length will be automatically set by the number of files.

e.g.:

File list: Here the files to be sorted and to be renamed are displayed with their intended prefix. Many entries can be chosen by holding down the shift or ctrl key.

Top: The chosen files in the list will be moved to the top of the list.

Up: The chosen files in the list will be moved one place up.

Down: The chosen files in the list will be moved one place down.

Bottom: The chosen files in the list will be moved to the bottom of the list.

Path: Here the actual path is been displayed.

Options: Here the program language can be chosen.
